Information

The Business Associate of Applied Science is a degree that combines two paths in one degree: Business Management and Accounting. The path the student chooses determines the specialization for the degree.

Business is a two-year management program that combines classroom with practical on-the-job training. The Business AAS curriculum includes courses designed to provide a practical, comprehensive program covering certain managerial/accounting activities. The program is designed to meet the needs of people preparing for careers in the business management or accounting industry.

Students enrolling into San Jacinto College programs with external learning experiences (i.e., clinical, practicum, externship, cooperative, etc.) will be required to comply with the immunization requirements and policies of the clinical/external learning sites to engage in all clinical/external learning experiences. Vaccination requirements at clinical/external learning sites are implemented pursuant to the independent authority of such facilities and are not mandated by San Jacinto College. Failure to meet the immunization requirements mandated by clinical/external learning sites may limit a student's ability to complete the program and/or may delay the student's graduation date. San Jacinto College does not process exemptions, and students should address potential vaccination exemptions directly with the clinical/external learning site.

Note: Students taking BUSG 2366 Practicum--Business/Commerce should be counseled by an advisor or the Department Chair prior to registration. The BUSG Practicum course helps students receive practical training and experience compatible with their business management or accounting career objectives.
