AUTO TECH, FORD AUTOMOTIVE STUDENT SERVICE EDUCATIONAL TRAINING (ASSET) PROGRAM, LEVEL 2 CERTIFICATE



Information

The Ford ASSET Level 2 Certificate prepares individuals for entry-level employment as automotive service technicians. San Jacinto College provides students the training they need. Today's automobiles are equipped with multiple computers and extensive electronics. Servicing vehicles equipped with active suspension, satellite guidance systems, and computer-controlled, multi-valve engines requires highly specialized training. Throughout the program, students are able to practice their learning during dealership-paid internships in the *Earn While You Learn* program. Upon the completion of this curriculum, students will have earned Ford certification and should be prepared to take the Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Certification exams and be ready for full-time employment at a Ford/Lincoln dealership. Students interested in the Ford Level 2 Certificate program must meet with the ASSET coordinator or Department Chair before registering for automotive classes.

Students enrolling into San Jacinto College programs with external learning experiences (i.e., clinical, practicum, externship, cooperative, etc.) will be required to comply with the immunization requirements and policies of the clinical/external learning sites to engage in all clinical/external learning experiences. Vaccination requirements at clinical/external learning sites are implemented pursuant to the independent authority of such facilities and are not mandated by San Jacinto College. Failure to meet the immunization requirements mandated by clinical/external learning sites may limit a student's ability to complete the program and/or may delay the student's graduation date. San Jacinto College does not process exemptions, and students should address potential vaccination exemptions directly with the clinical/external learning site.
