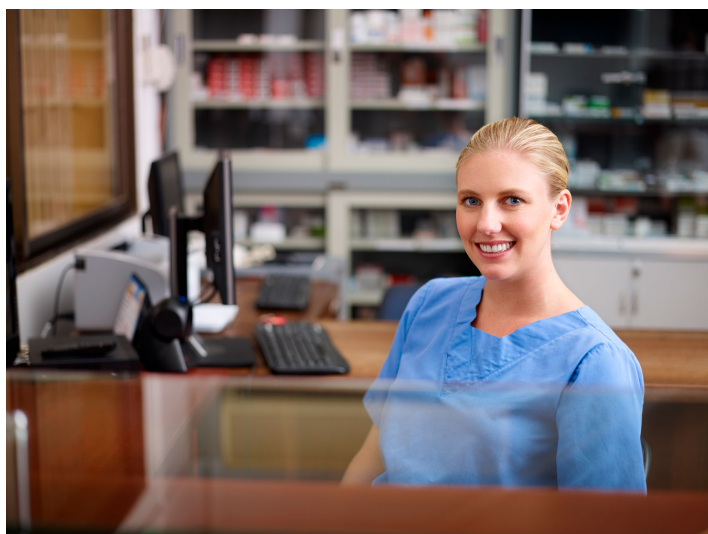


MEDICAL CODING SPECIALIST, LEVEL 2 CERTIFICATE
