With our certificate program, you are trained to be part of the clinical lab team collecting, labeling and processing specimens, recording information, as well as maintaining equipment.

You'll enjoy classes and labs as well as on-site experience at our affiliate hospital sites. After completing the one-year certificate, you'll be eligible to take the national certification exam and apply for the certification examination given by the American Medical Technologists (AMT).
