Program Admission Criteria

Applicants must meet all College general admission requirements.

Students who apply for admission to the Medical Laboratory Technology program will be ranked based on their scoring on the Medical Laboratory Technology selection Criteria Point System. Meeting the minimum requirements for admission does not guarantee admission.

Students must apply for admission to the program of Medical Laboratory Technology by submitting a formal application and all required official documents to the San Jacinto College Records Management Department.

In accordance with Texas House Bill 1508, the College informs all students in this program who may have a criminal background that a criminal history could keep graduates from being licensed by the state of Texas. Students with any questions about their background and licensure may speak with the Department Chair.

Applicants to the Medical Laboratory Technology program will be notified by mail regarding their program admission status. Applicants who are not selected for admission to the Medical Laboratory Technology program must re-apply if they want to be considered for the next term. Applicants who are accepted for admission to the Medical Laboratory Technology program but who do not enroll must re-apply. Applicants must meet the College's general admission requirements as well as the program admission criteria.

After acceptance into the program, an applicant must have a physical examination by a licensed physician, nurse practitioner, or physician's assistant and attend an orientation with a member of the Medical Laboratory Technology program.

Students are required to purchase uniforms and accessories.
