San Jacinto College designed the 1000-hour Barber program (31 college credits) to provide technical and practical instruction covering the art of barbering to include shaving, clipper cutting, men's grooming, and men's facials. The educational goal of the barbering course of study is to prepare for the state licensing examination and for profitable employment as a Class A barber. Students who successfully complete the barber curriculum are qualified to sit for the examination given by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation.
