EDTP 3301 Foundations of Inclusion and Differentiation for Special Populations 3 Credits (2 Lec, 2 Lab)

This course emphasizes how to develop a positive learning environment that supports the inclusion of diverse learners and students with exceptionalities in mainstream settings.

Course Type: Academic

EDTP 3303 Behavior Management in Special Populations 3 Credits (2 Lec, 2 Lab)

This course emphasizes classroom design, management, routines, social-emotional learning practices, and strategies for creating learning environments for students with exceptionalities and English language learners.

Course Type: Academic

EDTP 3305 Designing Assessments for General and Special Populations 3 Credits (2 Lec, 2 Lab)

The course covers appraisal techniques, including formal and informal assessments, employed by relevant disciplines in determining appropriate educational programming of students with exceptionalities and English language learners.

Course Type: Academic

EDTP 4310 Literacy in the Content Areas with Special Populations 3 Credits (2 Lec, 2 Lab)

This course covers understanding literacy in the content areas and planning instruction to promote content learning with an emphasis on adapting the school curriculum for special populations.
