SGNL 1401 Beginning American Sign Language I 4 Credits (3 Lec, 2 Lab)

This course offers an introduction to American Sign Language (ASL) covering finger spelling, vocabulary, and basic sentence structure in preparing individuals to interpret oral speech for the hearing impaired. The course also offers instruction in understanding the deaf culture. Students will spend three hours a week learning language patterns and forms and two hours a week in lab activities. SGNL 1402 Beginning American Sign Language II 4 Credits (3 Lec, 2 Lab)
