Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN-NURS)

The one-year BSN program is for the working registered nurse (RN with an associate degree) who wants to advance within the profession. The program follows an eight-week course model, building on previous education and experience while 100% distance learning opportunities that accommodate an employed RN's schedule. Bachelor of Applied Science in Early Childhood Education (BAS-EDU)
